Regulations of the Council of Engineers on  
Prohibited Diseases of Members of the Council of Engineers,  
B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000)

---

By virtue of Section 8 (6) (a) and Section 12 (6) of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (A.D. 1999), which is a law containing certain provisions relating to the restriction of rights and liberties of persons, for which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 39 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permitted by virtue of the provisions of law, the Council of Engineers issues these Regulations as follows:

Clause 1. These Regulations shall be called “Regulations of the Council of Engineers on Prohibited Diseases of Members of the Council of Engineers, B.E. 2543 (A.D. 2000).”

Clause 2. These Regulations shall be in force from the day following its publication in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3. The diseases prescribed under Section 12 (6) are:

- (1) Leprosy in infectious stage or phase when the symptoms are dangerous to society;
- (2) Tuberculosis in the phase dangerous to society;
- (3) Elephantiasis in the phase dangerous to society

- (4) Drug addiction
- (5) Alcoholism
