TABEE ORGANIZATION

- NON-GOVERNMENTAL
- UNCONTESTED OUTCOME-BASED ACCREDITATION AGENCY FOR ENGINEERING EDUCATION (ONLY ONE IN THAILAND UNDER THE WASHINGTON ACCORD)
- COET INITIATIVE WITH AUTONOMY IN MAKING ACCRED. DECISIONS
- LEGALLY INCORPORATED IN THAILAND JURISDICTION (THE ENGINEER ACT 1999 A.D.)
- INDEPENDENT FROM EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS
- NOT-FOR-PROFIT BASED ON COST RECOVERY (ACCREDITED PROGRAMS PAY FOR DIRECT COSTS)





TABEE POLICIES

- ACCREDITS ENGINEERING PROGRAMS, NOT INSTITUTIONS
- NOT COMPULSORY, UNIVERSITIES VOLUNTARILY APPLY FOR ACCRED.
- ADOPTS THE INTERNATIONAL BEST PRACTICE IN ENG. ACCRED.
- CLOSELY LINKED TO THE PROFESSION
- PROVIDES THIRD PARTY PEER REVIEW OF ENG. PROGRAMS
- PROGRAM EVALUATOR (PEV) TEAMS MUST CONSIST OF A MIX BETWEEN ACADEMICS AND PROFESSIONALS
- A TRUE FRIEND (KALYANAMIT) OF ENGINEERING PROGRAMS





TABEE CRITERIA

- DEVELOPED WITH REFERENCE TO THE WASHINGTON ACCORD GRADUATE ATTRIBUTES AS AN EXAMPLAR AND THE PRACTICES OF WASHINGTON ACCORD SIGNATORIES
- ADJUSTED TO THE THAI CONTEXTS (BOTH EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE)
- HIGH STANDARDS WITH 8 CRITERIA AND 11 PROGRAM (STUDENT) OUTCOMES
- HIGHLY QUALIFIED PROGRAM EVALUATORS FROM BOTH THE ACADEMIA AND THE PROFESSION
- PROVIDING THIRD PARTY POSITIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE COMMENTS
- IMPARTIAL ASSESSMENT YET FRIENDLY ATTITUDE TOWARDS UNIVERSITIES

- MUTUALLY RECOGNIZED UNDER THE WASHINGTON ACCORD (21 SIGNATORIES AND 7 PROVISIONAL MEMBERS AS IN 2021)
- PROVISIONAL STATUS IN 2019
- APPLYING FOR A SIGNATORY STATUS IN 2022 (DECISION WILL BE MADE IN JUNE 2022 TO FORM A WASHINGTON ACCORD VERIFICATION REVIEW TEAM)
- WILL BE PERIODICALLY REVIEWED EVERY 6 YEAR-CYCLE HENCEFORTH
