

## REGULATION OF THE COUNCIL OF ENGINEERS

on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level  
(No. 2), B.E. 2565 (2022)

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Regulation of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level, for the purpose of prescribing criteria for exemptions from the Knowledge Examination.

By virtue of Sections 8 (1) (6) (๓) (๔), 46 and 48 of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 , and in accordance with the resolution of the Ordinary General Meeting of the Council of Engineers held on 5 April B.E. 2565 (2022) and with the concurrence of the Honorary President of the Council of Engineers, the Council of Engineers hereby issues the following Regulation:

Clause 1 – Short Title. This Regulation shall be cited as the “Regulation of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level (No. 2), B.E. 2565 (2022).”

Clause 2 – Effective Date. This Regulation shall come into force on the day following its publication in the Royal Thai Government Gazette.

Clause 3 –Add the following provision as Clause 4/1 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Controlled Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level, B.E. 2561 (2018):

“Item 4/1 Any application, form, license, administrative order or other proceeding may be submitted or carried out in the form of electronic data and electronic transactions pursuant to the Royal Decree on Electronic Transactions or any other applicable law on electronic transactions.”

Clause 4 –Add the following paragraph as the second paragraph of Clause 13 of the Regulations of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Controlled Engineering Profession at the Associate Engineer Level, B.E. 2561 (2018):

“In the case of an applicant who has graduated from a degree program accredited by the Council of Engineers and possesses a certificate of work experience in the engineering profession for not less than twelve (12) months under the supervision of a person or agency to which the applicant belongs, as specified below, such applicant shall be exempted from the knowledge examination under (2) of paragraph one:

(1) A person who holds a professional engineering license at the level of Chartered Engineer (Professional Engineer) or higher in the same engineering discipline as the application submitted.

(2) The applicant’s direct supervisor in a government agency, state enterprise, public organization, or other state agency related to the practice of the engineering of the engineering profession.

(3) A Dean or an equivalent position of an educational institution, whether public or private.”
