REGULATION OF THE COUNCIL OF ENGINEERS on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer (No. 3), B.E. 2559 (2016)

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Regulation of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer

By virtue of the powers vested under Section 8 (6) (4) and (7) and Section 46, paragraph two of the Engineer Act B.E. 2542 (1999), and in accordance with the Ministerial Regulation Prescribing Branches of the Engineering Profession and the Controlled Engineering Profession B.E. 2550 (2007), the Council of Engineers, by resolution of the Extraordinary General Meeting No. 1/2557 (2014) held on 17 October 2014, and with the approval of the Supreme Council of the Council of Engineers, hereby issues the following Regulation:

Clause 1 This regulation shall be called the "Regulation of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer (No. 3), B.E. 2559 (2016)."

Clause 2 This regulation shall come into force on the day following its publication in the *Royal Gazette*.

Clause 3 The text of Clause 5 of the *Regulation of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the* Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer, *B.E. 2543 (2000)* is repealed and replaced with the following:

"Clause 5 An applicant for an Adjunct Engineer license may apply for one sub-discipline/branch at a time that is relevant to the applicant's work, together with evidence and documents showing the related work performed (including its quantity/volume) and evidence of the applicant's knowledge/competency assessment for professional practice. Upon passing the assessment, the applicant shall be granted a license to practice the Regulated Engineering Profession at the Adjunct Engineer.

In the case where the applicant seeks a license limited to certain branches/sub-disciplines, the application shall be submitted for those specific branches/sub-disciplines as prescribed by the Council of Engineers."

Clause 4 The wording in Clause 6 of the said Regulation of B.E. 2543 (2000) is amended by replacing the existing text with the word "work".

Clause 5 Applications for a license to practice the Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer that were submitted before the effective date of this Regulation shall continue to be processed and finalized under the Regulation of the Council of Engineers on the Issuance of Licenses to Practice the Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer, B.E. 2543 (2000).

Clause 6 Licenses to practice the Regulated Engineering Profession – Adjunct Engineer that were issued before the effective date of this Regulation shall remain valid until their expiry.
