

Regulation of the Council of Engineers

on Registration as ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineer (ACPE) (No. 4)

B.E. 2565 (2022)

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Regulations of the Board of the Council of Engineers on Registration as ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineer (ACPE), B.E. 2557 (2014).

By virtue of Section 33(3) of the Engineer Act, B.E. 2542 (1999), together with the resolutions of the Extraordinary General Meeting No. 1/2560 dated 6 July B.E. 2560 (2017) and the Board of the Council of Engineers Meeting No. 47-4/2565 dated 14 February B.E. 2565 (2022), the Board of the Council of Engineers hereby issues the following Regulation.

Clause 1 This Regulation shall be called the “Regulation of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Registration of ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineers (ACPE) (No. 4), B.E. 2565 (2022).”

Clause 2 This Regulations shall come into force on the day following their publication in the Royal Thai Government Gazette.

Clause 3 The provisions of Clause 7 of the Regulation of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Registration of ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineers (ACPE), B.E. 2557 (2014), are repealed and replaced by the following:

“Clause 7 Registration as an ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineer (ACPE) shall take effect from the date on which the registration is approved.”

Clause 4 The provisions of Clause 10 of the Regulation of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Registration of ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineers (ACPE), B.E. 2557 (2014), as amended by the Regulation of the Board of the Council of Engineers on the Registration of ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineers (ACPE) (No. 2), B.E. 2560 (2017), are repealed and replaced by the following:

“Clause 10 Registration shall terminate upon the occurrence of any of the following events with respect to the registrant:

- (1) death
- (2) suspension or revocation of the license to practice the regulated engineering profession.
- (3) a resolution of the Board of the Council of Engineers revoking the registration.

A person whose registration has terminated under (2) shall be prohibited from applying for registration as an ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineer (ACPE) again.”

Clause 5 ACPE registration certificates and ACPE renewal certificates issued prior to the effective date of this Regulation shall remain valid until their stated expiry dates.
